ORDER OF SUMMARY REVOCATION

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17 WHEREAS, Respondent RAYMOND WAYNE HRDLICKA was from June 6, 1986,
18 and now is, the holder of licenses issued by the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California to
19 act as a Bail Agent and Fire and Casualty Broker-Agent; and,

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21 WHEREAS, on March 15, 2001 in the State of Washington, Order No. D 01-13, before
22 the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Washington, Respondent's license and licensing rights to
23 act as a Bail Agent were REVOKED. The Insurance Commissioner of the State of Washington
24 issued the Order upon the following grounds:

- 25 1. An audit of Signature Bail Bonds, Inc., of which Respondent was President and
26 shareholder, revealed that collateral monies in licensee trust funds were commingled

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4 with non-trust monies. Commingled funds were used to cover business operating
5 expenses. This resulted in licensee having a greater liability than the trust account
6 could cover;

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8 2. The licensee sometimes failed to return collateral for a period of three or more weeks
9 after clients became eligible for collateral refunds. The licensee sometimes issued
10 collateral refund checks that could not be cashed due to insufficient funds;

11 3. The facts stated herein constitute violations of Washington statutes governing the
12 conduct of bail licensees, and Respondent RAYMOND WAYNE HRDLICKA was
13 thus deemed untrustworthy, a source of injury and loss to the public, and not
14 qualified to be an insurance agent in the State of Washington, and his licenses and
15 licensing rights were REVOKED; and
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18 WHEREAS, California Insurance Code Sections 1669(d) and 1821, in conjunction
19 with Section 1738, authorize the Insurance Commissioner to revoke without hearing, the licenses
20 and licensing rights of a person who has had a professional, occupational or vocational license
21 suspended or revoked for cause by any licensing authority within five years;
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24 NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority of California Insurance Code
25 Sections 1669(d) and 1821, in conjunction with Section 1738, the Insurance Commissioner hereby

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orders that the licenses and licensing rights of Respondent to act as a Bail Agent and as a Fire and Casualty Broker-Agent be, and the same hereby are, REVOKED, effective 30 days from the date of this order.
