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WHEREAS, Respondent, DENNIS JOSEPH KYNE JR., was from March 21, 1997 through March 8, 2000 the holder of an unrestricted license issued by the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California to act as a life agent, and, was from March 9, 2000 through March 31, 2001, and from March 28, 2002 through March 31, 2003, and was from May 6, 2003, and now is, the holder of a restricted license issued by the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California to act as a life agent; and,

WHEREAS, on December 23, 1998, in Case No. C9810970, in the Municipal Court of Santa Clara County, State of California, Respondent was convicted upon a plea of nolo contendere of petty theft, in violation of Section 484/488 of the California Penal Code; a misdemeanor; and,

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2000, in Case No. SAC 9941-AP, before the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California, Respondent's unrestricted license to act as a life agent was revoked and there was issued to Respondent a restricted license to act as a life agent due to Respondent's December 23, 1998 conviction and his failure to disclose that conviction on his application to renew his life agent license; and,

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2000, in Case No. CC063102, in the Superior Court of Santa Clara County, San Jose Facility, State of California, Respondent was convicted upon a plea of guilty of resisting, delaying, obstructing an officer, in violation of Section 148(a)(1) of the California Penal Code; a misdemeanor; and,

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2002, in Case No. 02-C27937, before the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wisconsin, Respondent's application for a license to act as an insurance agent was denied for failing to disclose the March 9, 2000 administrative action taken by the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, the abovementioned September 24, 2002 administrative action taken by the State of Wisconsin was not disclosed on Respondent's application to renew his restricted life agent license; and,

WHEREAS, California Insurance Code Section 1669(c), in conjunction with Section 1738, authorizes the Insurance Commissioner to revoke without hearing, the licenses and licensing rights of a person who has had a previous application for a professional, occupational, or vocational license denied for cause by any licensing authority within five years of the date of the filing of the application to acted upon;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority of California Insurance Code Section 1669(c), in conjunction with Section 1738, the Insurance Commissioner hereby orders that the licenses and licensing rights of Respondent be, and the same hereby are, REVOKED, effective 30 days from the date of this order.
